About Us

The Alpena Baby Pantry is a program of the Alpena and Presque Isle Child Abuse and Neglect (CA/N) Team, which is a local council of Michigan's Children's Trust Fund. The Alpena Baby Pantry does not exist to meet every need of families, but works to support families with some basic necessities during tough times. The Baby Pantry is run exclusively by volunteers. Proof of income is not expected. Parents only need to show a birth certificate at their initial visit to the Baby Pantry.

What is available for families?

Diapers, baby food, formula clothing, toys, equipment and more are all available for free to families within stated limits. Expectant moms may get items for their baby in their 8th month of pregnancy. Each is also given a 'Baby Shower in a Bag' before birth of their baby.
